• Entry Fee: \$25 per competitor per routine, including alternates. Make check payable to USA Synchro. Any

swimmer who is listed as an alternate for a routine and who is not swimming any other routine event

shall pay the entry fee. (Rulebook, Appendix C)

• Surcharge: \$5 per competitor, including alternates. Make check payable to USA Synchro. Any swimmer who is

listed as an alternate for a routine and who is not swimming any other routine event shall pay the

surcharge. This surcharge is to cover expenses for Officials. (Rulebook, Appendix C)

• Sponsor Fee: \$20 per competitor. Make check payable to USA Synchro.

• Credentials: Each club will receive credentials for 2 coaches and 1 chaperone per 10 registered athletes.

Each club will receive one video camera credential for the meet.

Additional coach and chaperone credentials are available for \$15 each.

Lost/misplaced credentials will be \$15 for replacement.

Finals tickets for each age group event (11-12, 13-15, 16-17 & 18-19) are \$10 for general admission,


5.1.2.Use the drop-down arrow to choose the athlete (participant) entering the event.






5.1.4. Click "Continue" and your shopping cart will reflect a summary of your transaction.






5.2.5.Please ignore the Security and Invitation fields. This would be used only if each individual registered themselves.




5.2.6. Scroll down to answer the following questions. It is not necessary to click "Save", but it will save your answers.



- 5.2.10. Use the dropdown arrow to choose the athlete (participant) and click "Continue".
- 5.2.11. Use the dropdown arrow to choose the same team, or click "Add Team" to create your next team.




- 6. Review your shopping cart carefully to make sure that all entries are correct.
- 7. Click "Continue" to proceed to checkout.

8. Verify that the total charges are correct and click the checkbox to acknowledge the wavier. (You must scroll within the text box for the checkbox to become active.)

#### A few items of note:
